

Dear prayer supporters,

I mentioned in our last prayer letter that the property we were trying to purchase fell through. Since that time we continued to look for other properties, but could find nothing even close to our price range or similar to the one we had "lost." About 20 days ago, the realtor got back in touch with us to ask if we would still be interested in that property. Of course, we were! So, he renegotiated with the sellers, and a couple of week ago we were able to sign the papers for the purchase of the original property! For \$5,000.00 LESS than the previous deal! So, we are very thankful for this purchase, and thankful that some funds were saved which will be used for construction on the same property.

This purchase included the past couple of months of paperwork, and then since everything here is done in cash, I had to arrange for an armored car to transport the funds from my bank to the bank of the sellers! That was an interesting transaction to say the least. But of course, God is faithful and everything was signed and the transaction was made without incident.

Related to our future move to begin a church plant in Vicente Lopez / Olivos area, we took a special offering in our church on Sunday for the construction in Vicente Lopez. The church gave an initial offering of about U\$\$ 4,500.00 which is a very good offering for our people. Our daughter churches will also contribute to this fund and our people will continue to give for several weeks. Although the Lord has provided funds from outside our church and outside our country, we are thankful that our people have learned to give sacrificially and generously toward the foundation of our daughter churches.

Our church has been gearing up for our Christmas musical. This year we plan to do 7 presentations. This is a great opportunity for us to share the gospel with people who have never heard. Please pray for us as we prepare and then that many visitors would come and that the Holy Spirit would work in a powerful way during the Christmas season.

Please pray about an issue on our pastoral team that we have been dealing with the past few weeks. It has been clear that God has given wisdom and clarification during the past week, but the issue apparently will not be resolved as we had hoped. So pray for us as we lead our church through a challenge that we will have to deal with in the next several weeks.
