Please continue to pray for our choir and orchestra as they continue to prepare for our Christmas musical. We plan to do 7 presentations this year. This is a great opportunity for us to share the gospel with people who have never heard. Please pray for us as we prepare and then that many visitors would come and that the Holy Spirit would work in a powerful way during the Christmas season.
