FAMILY DEVOTIONAL FOR WEEK OF 6/19

Initial Question: *Who do you look up too, and in what ways do they imitate Jesus?*

Read: Philippians 2:1-8

This passage is hard to practice. Doing nothing that is selfish seems impossible. Looking always to what others want seems like no fun. But, this is what this passage clearly says. The example given is Jesus. Look at some of the things Paul says Jesus did. 1). Willing chose not to use some divine powers. 2). Came to a normal family. 3). Served others. 4). Willing suffered a rejection and a horrible death.

- *What are some things Jesus did that show you came to serve people?*
- *How did Jesus coming into a normal family, help us relate to Him?*
- *We know Jesus worked hard in life, was rejected, and died a brutal death. What do you have to do this week that seems unfair but you know you need to just do it?*
- *What specific things can you do this week, that you didn't do last week, that will show others they are valuable to you?*
